

# FYAA PARENT AND PLAYER INFORMATION

## Contact

1. Display a good attitude with a willingness to work toward an enjoyable season.
2. Follow the direction of the coaching staff.
3. Show concern for any property of any practice and/or game site and show proper care for any equipment.
4. Follow specific rules of the FYAA Board.
5. Any player engaging in conduct detrimental to the team, i.e. fighting, bad language, poor sportsmanship, is subject to the following disciplinary action:
  - First Offense: warning
  - Second Offense: one-week suspension
  - Third Offense: player is removed for the remainder of the year
  - **Parents will be notified of each incident. If a player is removed, there will not be a refund of the registration fee.**
6. Only the coaching staff and authorized personnel are allowed on the practice and game fields.
7. The game field is off limits during practice sessions. Parents are responsible for keeping their other children and guests off of the game field.
8. No Pets are permitted on the game field at any time. Pets brought to practice must be kept on a leash and must be cleaned up after. If a pet becomes a nuisance, the FYAA board reserves the right to prohibit the pet from returning to the facility.
9. There will not be any alcoholic products or profanity permitted at any time. **There will not be any smoking in the game field area. Smoking at practice will be limited to the parking lot.**
10. Fees for football players are \$130 before July 13 and \$180 thereafter. The fee includes all equipment used (helmet, shoulder pads, game pants, all pads for the pants and a game jersey). The player will provide practice jersey, practice pants, football cleats and protective cup. All FYAA equipment is to be returned at the end of the season.
11. **Players must have a current physical exam before they can start practice. A copy of his/her birth certificate must be on file with the team mom. All fees and paperwork must be turned in before any equipment will be issued to a player. Parents will also sign a form stating that their child has received the equipment and that the equipment will be returned clean and in good condition at the end of the season. Equipment will be issued the week of July 27th. Equipment returns dates will be Nov. 14 and Nov. 17 from 5:00- 8:00pm at the football field.**
12. **Refunds** – FYAA will issue refunds of half the entry fee during the first two weeks of practice, upon the return of all issued equipment. There will not be a refund given after the second week of practice!
13. The first practice is July 27. Practices are Mon. through Thur. 6:30 – 8:30pm. After school starts, practice is Tues. through Thur. 6:00 – 8:00pm depending on your coaching staff. Please be on time! Players should bring their own water bottles.
14. Team picture day is scheduled for Aug. 9. Details will be announced later.
15. Practice will be held in the rain, cold, and snow. The only time practice is cancelled is when lightning is present. Practice will be held unless you are notified.
16. It is mandatory that a parent be present at practice.
17. Weigh-ins will be held on Aug. 1 at Fairfield's youth field. Games will be played on Saturdays. Our first game is scheduled for Aug. 22. **The Super bowl is Nov. 14 at.**
18. **PLAYING TIME IS NOT GUARANTEED.**
19. **Every parent will be asked to work the concession stand at least twice per family. If you do not work at least twice, your son/daughter will not be permitted to play in the first playoff game unless some other arrangements are made with the board.**
20. These rules are set forth to provide equal enjoyment by all participants and may be modified or added to throughout the year by the FYAA Board.
